

# Church Camp Packing List:

- ❑ Sleeping bag and a pillow / or sheets and a blanket (something for your bunk bed)
- ❑ Towels, washcloth, soap, shampoo, conditioner, hand sanitizer toilet articles and other "necessities"
- ❑ 4-5 Regular changes of underclothes and socks
  - ❑ Make sure it's casual clothing. Bring clothes such as jeans, shorts, and long and short sleeve shirts.  
Include couple pairs of comfortable sneakers or shoes. Bring clothing for both warm and cool weather.  
HOODIES/zip up jackets are a must for campfires. 😊
- ❑ Pajamas
- ❑ A warm jacket and hat. The days are usually warm, but the nights and any rainy days sometimes get cool
- ❑ Rain apparel – it seems when it rains, it pours around here in the summer!
- ❑ Swimsuit(s) – We recommend at least two so you won't have to wear a wet suit all week. Our lake has a dock, a lifeguard and lifejackets and other fun floatation devices to play with. We also offer canoeing with an experience adult.
- ❑ Suntan lotion – a must, so you don't burn
- ❑ Water Bottle – there is a camp water fountain and water jug to keep campers hydrated in the sun!
- ❑ Sunglasses for that bright morning sun at Inspiration Point
- ❑ Insect repellent. We recommend pump sprays instead of aerosols
- ❑ Flashlight with fresh batteries
- ❑ Musical instruments. If you play and would like to share we'd certainly appreciate it!
- ❑ Camera and film – (unless digital). The single use cameras are perfect for younger kids to take to camp!
- ❑ A little money – the camp store will be open when you get to camp and when you leave as well as soda and candy for afternoon snacks.
- ❑ If you bring any prescription medications (or other vitamins, aspirin or health care stuff) please bring them to registration with you. As per state law, we are required to collect at registration and store all of these items with our camp nurse or manager along with a note of any important instructions for administration.
- ❑ A positive attitude. This is really important! Seriously!

*We recommend that you mark all clothing and belongings with a permanent marker. Unfortunately there are many pieces of clothing left at camp each summer which are not claimed and are not identifiable. This substantial lost and found pile is held on site into the fall and then given to charity. While we're happy these items find a good home eventually, we feel bad that the person who owns the clothing will never see it again!*

## **Items Not to Bring:**

- ! Skateboards, Rollerblades, Mini Bikes
- ! Radios or CD players (iPods are okay ... but are easily stolen)
- ! Cellular phones
- ! Pets – Teddy Bears are encouraged to come to camp, though
- ! Siblings – unless they are registered... 😊
